### <u>F.S. 270.11(3):</u>

Rights of entry automatically released for any property that is or has been a continuous tract of less than 20 acres of land under the same ownership.

The automatic release of rights of entry had previously only applied to TIIF and the Board of Education.

Miami-Dade Ordinance 18-12 amended section 18-20.2

- = Passed on Feb. 6, 2018
- = Property located in special taxing districts
  - Requires Sellers to include notice in deed
  - Requires Sellers to record buyer's notarized acknowledgment
